Crossroads of Michigan Receives \$35,000 Skillman Foundation Grant

Crossroads Sunday Soup Kitchen, Summer Lunch Program, Life Skills, and Job Club will also benefit from the grant.

"Created in 1960, The Skillman Foundation is a private philanthropy whose chief aim is to help develop good schools and good neighborhoods for children. Though grants are made throughout metropolitan Detroit, most grants are directed at six Detroit neighborhoods-Southwest Detroit (Vernor and Chadsey/ Condon), Brightmoor, Osborn, and Cody/Rouge and the Northend- and toward innovative and successful schools throughout the city of Detroit."

Crossroads is a non-profit social service outreach agency offering counseling, advocacy, and emergency assistance to people in need. Crossroads serves its clients through two social service units, a Sunday Soup Kitchen, and a no fee employment service, the Crossroads Employment Office (CEO).
