**Crossroads Celebrates 40 Years and St. Martin's Day at The Cathedral Church of St. Paul**

Detroit, Mich- Crossroads of Michigan will celebrate its 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary this Sunday, November 13 with a service at The Cathedral Church of St. Paul. The non-profit's annual gathering is held on St. Martin's Day, in honor of Crossroads' patron Saint. The morning's service will feature Christ Church Grosse Pointe's interim rector, The Reverend Dr. Andrew MacBeth, as guest preacher.

Crossroads has a long history with The Cathedral, going back to the very beginning. The organization originated in the Episcopal Church in 1971, serving the poor and homeless in Detroit. Forty years later, Crossroads has two social service units with its main office now located on West Grand Boulevard. The organization offers "A hand up and the gift of hope" in the form of clothing, food, bus fare, identification, prescription assistance, an employment office, a Sunday soup kitchen and, most importantly, counseling to all those who come to their door.

The service will begin at 10:30a.m. Sunday, November 13 at 4800 Woodward Avenue in Detroit. Those interested in joining Crossroads procession into the church will meet at 10:15a.m. All are invited to join in snacks and refreshments at Barth Hall immediately following the service.
